We were able to send a church cheque for £1075 to the **Oxford Night Shelter**. Thank you on their behalf. GLK

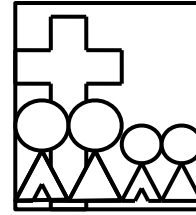
Jane Lusty has produced a report based on a survey of her church family on why they come to church. Additional copies are available in the foyer. Please take a moment to read it.
