Please pray for our minister, Paul Carter, and his family, as his sister Catherine passed away in the early hours of Thursday in hospital in Birmingham.

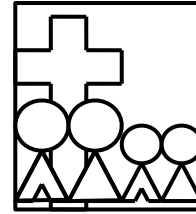
